He was also frequently called upon by the RCMP as a volunteer searcher. While his focus is now hunting human prey on "Mantracker," he remains active in search and rescue, speaking to groups about tracking and, search and rescue techniques. He was recently contracted by the British military to teach soldiers ground sign recognition, extra training that may help them locate IEDs as they are deployed to Afghanistan next year.
